INFORMATION CONCERNING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING IN RELATION TO VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is "Dom Development" S.A. with its registered office in Warsaw, Pl. Piłsudskiego 3, 00-078 Warszawa (hereinafter the "Controller").
- 2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, whom you may contact in respect of any matters relating to the protection of your personal data:
 - a) by e-mail to: iodo@domd.pl,
 - b) by letter to: "Dom Development" S.A., Pl. Piłsudskiego 3, 00-078 Warszawa, marked with the reference "IODO". In particular, you may contact the Controller in the above manner in order to exercise your rights referred to in items 7 and 8.
- 3. Your personal data captured through video surveillance of the Controller's premises (including of the workplace) is processed for the purpose of ensuring the safety of persons (including employees) and the protection of property, and for the purpose of maintaining the confidentiality of information whose disclosure could harm the Controller and for the purpose of establishing and investigating or defending claims in connection with the above.

The legal basis for this processing is the legitimate interest of the Controller (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) in ensuring the safety of persons (including employees), in the protection of property and maintaining the secrecy of certain information.

- 4. Video surveillance recordings containing your personal data will be stored for a period of no longer than three months from the date of recording, unless they constitute evidence in a legal proceeding or unless the Controller has become aware that they might constitute evidence in a legal proceeding, in which case the time period for their storage shall be extended until such proceeding has been finally concluded.
- 5. The recipients of your personal data may include:
 - a) employees and contractors of the Controller,
 - b) entities that provide services to the Controller, in particular, IT services, surveillance system maintenance and service, and physical security services, to whom the Controller will entrust the processing of your personal data.
- 6. Your personal data will not be transferred to any third country, i.e. to any country outside the European Economic Area.
- 7. You have the right to request access to your personal data, to rectify or delete your personal data as well to request the restriction of processing of your personal data.
- 8. You have the right to object to the processing for reasons associated with your particular situation.
- 9. You have the right to file a complaint with the data protection authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office).
- 10. The provision of data recorded through video surveillance is not a statutory or contractual obligation and is voluntary. This data is collected automatically through video surveillance system.
- 11. The Controller will not make decisions based exclusively on automated processing, including profiling, which may have a legal effect or similar material effect on you.
