PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING INFORMATION

Your personal data is processed in accordance with Regulation No. 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general data protection regulation) (hereinafter the "GDPR").

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is Dom Development Wrocław Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Wrocław, ul. Kazimierza Wielkiego 1, 50-077 Wrocław (hereinafter the "Controller").
- 2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, whom you may contact in respect of any matters relating to the protection of your personal data:

In particular, you may contact the Controller in the above manner in order to exercise your rights referred to in items 7 and 8 and/or to withdraw your consent, as referred to in item 9.

- 3. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of:
- a) making a contact and assessing the possibility of a potential real property purchase, on the basis of your consent, if such consent has been given by you (legal basis: Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR), or
- b) taking action on your request before the conclusion of the agreement, where such request has been made by you, and also for the purpose of the performance of such agreement (legal basis: Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR), or
- c) arranging a meeting with you in order for you to present your terms for the sale of real property and to reach an agreement with you on such terms, which constitutes a legitimate interest of the Controller (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), or
- d) discharging the Controller's legal obligations (legal basis: Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR), or
- e) the establishment, exercise or defence of claims (if any), which constitutes a legitimate interest of the Controller (legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).
- 4. Your personal data will be processed:
- a) until the withdrawal of your consent to the processing of your personal data, if the processing is on the basis of your consent, where the processing takes place for the purpose referred to in item 3(a), or
- b) with regard to the purpose referred to in item 3(b) for the period required for signing and performing the agreement, or
- c) with regard to the pursuit of the legitimate interests of the Controller referred to in item 3(c) until the lodgement of an objection, or
- d) with regard to the Controller's legal obligations, referred to in item 3(d) for the period required for the Controller to discharge these obligations, or

- e) with regard to the establishment, exercise or defence of claims, referred to in item 3(e) for the limitation periods for claims as set out by law.
- 5. The recipients of your personal data may include:
- a) employees and contractors of the Controller, or
- b) notaries, or
- c) entities that provide services to the Controller, in particular, IT, courier, consulting and audit, property management or project development services to whom the Controller has entrusted or may entrust the processing of your personal data.
- 6. Your personal data will not be transferred to any third country, i.e. to any country outside the European Economic Area.
- 7. You have the right to request access to your personal data, to rectify or delete your personal data, to request the restriction of processing of your personal data and to transfer your data.
- 8. If your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests, you have the right to object to the processing for reasons associated with your particular situation.
- 9. To the extent to which you have given consent to the processing of your personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time, without impacting on the legality of the processing of your personal data that has been done on the basis of your consent prior to its withdrawal. 10. You have the right to file a complaint with the data protection authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office).
- 11. The provision of your personal data is voluntary. Failure to provide such data will render it impossible to process your personal data for the purposes of making contact and assessing the possibility of a potential real property purchase, taking actions before signing and performing an agreement and/or arranging a meeting with you.
